- Cardio-Respiratory Arrest
- Shocked Patient
- Unconscious Patient
- Anaphylaxis
- Abdominal Pain
- Blackout / Collapse
- Breathlessness
- Chest Pain
- Confusion, Acute / Delirium
- Fever
- Fits / Seizure
- Haematemesis & Melaena
- Palpitations
- Poisoning
- Weakness and Paralysis
- Medical Problems / Complications following Surgery
- Medical Problems in Pregnancy
