**Junior doctor shift patterns:** 1A banded full shift

**Consultant shift pattern:** 1 : 8 on call. Resident Monday to Friday 08:00 till 18:00. Responsible only for the ICU.

**ICNARC case mix:** We admit 350 – 400 patients a year for level 3 care. About 30% of these are post surgical patients ( emergency & elective). The mean APACHE II score was 15.9.

**Patient populations unique to unit (e.g. transplant, hepatobiliary, neuro, etc):** Vascular surgery patients, haematology patients.

**FFICM exam practice (consultants willing to Viva):** All will be willing to provide practice. Dr.Cook is a FRCA examiner & Dr.Saha is an EDIC examiner.

**Frequency and type of governance meetings:** Mortality meetings once every 2 months. Combined audit meetings with anaesthetic department once every 2 months.

**Management opportunities:** Can provide opportunity to run the ward rounds, review / write protocols.

**Unit teaching programme:** Combined teaching programme with NMGH. 3 hour teaching session a week.
