About

This course is specifically focused on all aspects of the Final FRCA exam, and complements the weekly local teaching programme and the MFT Final FRCA course. It comprises:

- an introductory half day, outlining revision and written exam strategies
- a two-month correspondence CRQ course
- RCoA-style MCQ papers to go through at home
- two study days, covering mock-CRQ papers and mock- and interactive-SBAs
- a viva intro afternoon, a morning dedicated to anatomy for the viva and two viva practice days

The emphasis of the course is on exam technique as well as knowledge, and the format has been fine-tuned over the years.

The course is free for ST trainees in the North West school, on the understanding that you contribute to the question bank, and help mark the correspondence course once the Final hurdle has been cleared. NW SAS doctors – there may be space for you on the course – please email to enquire.
